Parish Pilot Project - update



The start date of this has been delayed until next month due to resource issues.

The remit of the project is a 12-month trial with self selecting Parish & Community Groups to determine viability.

Parishes were asked to volunteer for inclusion in this project in a variety of roles, some being a trusted reporter to advise on defects etc. This project aims to resolve issues where LCC are unable to carry out action requested by the local community but unable to allow, assist or permit communities to carry out work themselves.

- Identify principles & practices, general & particular
- Confirm Insurance, Risk Assessments and Permit arrangements processes
- Agree range of tasks
- Undertake training
- Agree performance indicators
- 3-monthly review periods, evaluating pros & cons for both sides
- After 12 months roll out to certain Parish, Town Councils who wish to be involved (voluntary/self selecting)
- June 2023 August 2023 (preparation)
- Commence September 2023
