

Hallaton Parish Neighbourhood Plan Referendum

3rd June 2021

The Hallaton Neighbourhood Plan has successfully been through Examination and approved by Harborough District Council to go to Referendum. **The date for the Referendum is confirmed as Thursday 3rd June.**

Polling Station

The Referendum is organised by Electoral Services, as with any election. **Polling will take place at the Stenning Hall, Horn Lane, Hallaton LE16 8UG between 7am and 10pm.**

The Referendum is taking place during the school half term so if you are away, you can apply for a postal vote.

Postal votes

The same rules apply for postal votes. If you are already permanently registered for a postal vote for elections, you will automatically receive a postal vote.

For others, if you are not able to, or prefer not to, vote in person on the day, you can apply for a postal vote. The number to call to request a postal vote is [01858 821372](tel:01858821372) or email e.services@harborough.gov.uk.

The closing date for applying for a postal vote is 5pm on Tuesday 18th May.
